Turners syndrome females have low estradiol and treatment helped cognition (ross 2000

472 women followed for 16 years with every 2 years followup. Recorded use of ERT 3 years plus or minus and included past users. 95% used oral and only 5% used transdermal. Relative risk was .49 and also NASID .45

Working memory and how estradiol helps (Shaywitz 1997)

Vitamin E 2000 units plus Selegiline (MAO inhibitor) slows progression of AD (Sano 1997)

Estradiol increases acetylcholinesterase activity in brain (Luine 1985)

Estrogen receptors in limbic, basel forebrain, cortex in females and males (Torran-Allerand 1992)

Acute estrogen increases glucose uptake in brain (Namba 1984)

Premarin does not seem to help (Wang 2000)
